Another Victory for the Southerns

By a dispatch received from Louisville, Ky., we learn that the Southerns beat the Kentuckys, of that city, in a full game yesterday afternoon, the score standing 43 to 25 in favor of the Southerns. The early part of the game must have been very interesting, as in the sixth inning the Kentuckys had 15 runs to 14 for their opponent, and they at the bat with only one man out. At the seventh inning our champions woke up, for in that and the eighth and ninth innings they made 29 runs. To-day, it is expected they will play the Eagles, and the result of the game will be looked for with interest, as the Eagles, although a junior club, are spoken of as being the crack club of Kentucky, and continual travel and play must have begun to tell on our boys.

SCORE OF THE UNION GAME

We give below a condensed report of the above game, which appears to have been the poorest played by our boys in St. Louis, a fact which is no doubt attributable to their having been considerably tired out, and because Chandler was absent from the right field, together with the severe accident that Donovan received in the first inning, by being struck in the face by the ball, the pain of which no doubt caused him to let several balls pass him. In the fifth inning Larkin played catcher, but Donovan resumed his place in the sixth, and Buddendorf seemed to have lost some of his usual luck, for he muffed several balls that should have been taken on the fly or sent to first base in time to head off the striker. The catchers on both sides had a full share of work. Gorman, of the Unions, put out seven; Donovan and Larkin, of the Southerns, putting out eight – six by the former and two by the latter.
